

SCNA Coaching and Officiating Course Contribution

In order to better support our Somerset based volunteers, SCNA are committed to assisting with funding of Officiating and Coaching courses as well as being a point of contact and provide information about upcoming courses and assist with progress up the pathway.

Participants may of course wish to approach their local club to assist with further financial contribution and provide practice opportunities. If a participant struggles with obtaining practising opportunities please let SCNA know as we may be able to assist.

Participants will be required to outline their plans for using any course and details will be included on the Expression of Interest form. SCNA may also require a Club referee and their details to be added to any application in order to verify the use of the course, mentorship available at club level and future progression for the participant.

Funding

SCNA may (at its discretion) contribute funds for course fees (up to 25% of the total costs) for participants within Somerset to be put towards coaching and officiating courses. Such courses include:-

- Level 1 Coaching;
- Level 2 Coaching
- Level 3 Coaching
- Into Officiating
- C Award - Officiating
- B Award – Officiating
- A Award - Officiating

**Note that CPD and workshops are not subject to this funding.*

Funding Terms

The terms of such funding may apply:-

- Participants who wish to apply for any courses (including CPD) must complete the 'SCNA Expression of Interest form' available on the website;
- SCNA will contact the participant and referee for further information with regard to the application as well as to approve or deny the course contribution;
- Participants must book the relevant course via the EN website and pay for the course upfront;
- Participants must complete an 'SCNA Expenses form' available on the SCNA website;
- Participants will be expected to at the request of SCNA to contribute volunteer time for SCNA events to in return for funding contributed by SCNA and will be contacted within the relevant current season; and
- Such volunteer time not to exceed 5 hours.
