

Somerset County Junior Netball Code of Conduct



To ensure all players have a positive netball experience and to ensure the health and safety of players, umpires during matches SCNA ask that spectators stand outside of the courts to observe games unless you are a nominated official by your club.

We also ask that you remember the below points when observing junior fixtures:

As a parent/carer/supporter, I will:

- Abide by and enforce the 'respect line' at all fixtures
- Uphold the 'Photography Policy' and ensure appropriate consent has been gained and permission has been granted at every fixture
- Encourage the team to play within the rules and respect officials' and coaches' decisions
- Support the efforts and performance of every team, give positive comments that motivate and encourage continued effort and learning
- Be a positive role model and always promote good sportsmanship
- Remember that we learn best by example; I will applaud good play of all teams
- Thank the coaches, officials and other volunteers who give their time and not interfere with their decisions
- Read the rules of the sport to understand netball better
- Promote this code of conduct to other parents, carers and supporters

As a parent/carer/supporter, I will not:

- Pressure players in any way; this is their sport not mine
- Use inappropriate language, negatively comment during play, harass players, coaches, officials or other spectators
- Criticise or ridicule a player for making a mistake or losing
- Force a player if they are unwilling to participate in the sport

Please note that should any behaviour courtside not follow the Codes of Conduct above you may be asked not to observe fixtures.
